There are so many scriptures about God's love that you can use for this activity.

Here are the ones I used. And yes, I did use the same verse for each child but not on the same day.

John 3:16 For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son so that whoever believes in Him will not perish but have everlasting life.

1 John 4:19 We love because He first loved us.

2Thessalonians 3:3 But the Lord is faithful. He will establish and guard you against the evil one.

Psalm 86:13 For great is your steadfast love toward me.

Psalm 40:17 As for me I am poor and needy, but the Lord takes thought for me.

Psalm 42:8 By day the Lord commands his steadfast love and at night His song is with me.

Psalm 136:23 It is He who remembered us in our low estate for His steadfast love endures forever.

Psalm 136:24 And rescued us from our foes, for His steadfast love endures forever.

Ephesians 1:4-5 In love He predestined us for adoptions as sons through Christ Jesus, according to the purpose of His will.

Ephesians 2:4-5 But God being rich in mercy because of the great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ-- by grace you have been saved.

Isaiah 43:1 (b) Fear not for I have redeemed you I have called you by name.

Isaiah 43:4 Because you are precious in my eyes and honored, and I love you.

Isaiah 42: 6 I am the Lord, I have called you in righteousness I will take you by the hand and keep you.

Zephaniah 3:17 The Lord your God is in your midst, a mighty one who will save you; He will rejoice over you with gladness, He will quiet you by His love.

Deuteronomy 31:6 & 8 Be strong and courageous. Do not fear or be in dread of them for it is the Lord your God who goes with you, He will not leave you or forsake you.
